

# SWANSEA AIR SHOW DISRUPTION 29TH & 30TH JUNE

Swansea will be hosting the annual air show on Saturday and Sunday this week (30th June and 1st July). This year, the decision has been made to close part of Oystermouth Road and Mumbles Road between 10am on Friday 29th June until 6am on Monday 2nd July. The closure will be between Brynmill Lane and the Civic Centre; this will affect services 5, 9, 24, 35, 37, 43 and 54.

## SERVICES 5 & 9

These local Swansea City Centre services to Cwmdonkin and North Hill are expected to be disrupted due to the nature of the routes and that they are confined in their entirety to the city centre and nearby areas. These services may be subject to short notice changes and cancellations.

## SERVICE 37

The route will not change; however, we expect that many people will travel through the Uplands and down Sketty Lane as the main diversionary route around the closure. Resulting high volumes of traffic may cause delays.

## SERVICE 43

From Swansea Bus Station, the service will divert via Uplands along Walter Road, Uplands Crescent and Sketty Road (and vice-versa inbound to Swansea). This is the main diversionary route for traffic and therefore it is expected to cause severe traffic congestion.

Throughout Friday and Saturday:

- Singleton Hospital will not be served; for alternative buses towards the city centre, please see service 37 which picks up on Sketty Lane.
- Journeys serving Sketty Park will turn left at De La Beche Road/Sketty Cross and serve Sketty Park as normal
- Journeys not serving Sketty Park will turn right at Sketty Cross and rejoin the normal route towards Broadway/Tycoch College
- On Friday, the 15:05 departure from Swansea will operate around the loop at Sketty Cross/De La Beche Road in order to pick up Bishop Gore School pupils at the normal bus stop.

Whilst we understand that the road closure will be lifted in one direction between 3pm and 7pm on Friday, to avoid confusion service 43 will continue to observe its diversionary route during this period.

## SERVICES 24, 35 & 54

These routes will not change, but likely traffic congestion from people accessing the city centre and diverting around the closures via official diversions is expected to disrupt services and cause delays.
